



The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), the department of the federal government with responsibility for CACFP, has released the new meal reimbursement rates effective July 1, 2020. These rates are the amount of money per meal/snack, per child that you will receive from July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022.

**NOTE: Family Child Care Providers are ALL Tier 1 starting July 1, 2021 for a period of one year through June 30, 2022, because of USDA Eligibility Waivers.**
